Bledsoe County Fairest of the Fair Pageant Rules

All Age Groups

1. Deadline for entering is Wednesday, August 7, 2019 at 6 pm at Bledsoe County Fairgrounds. Queen Interviews August 10th ages 14 and up at 2pm.
2. The Bledsoe County Fair Association is not responsible for any injury, loss or damages incurred coming to, during or leaving from pageant.
3. The judge's decision will remain final. There will be absolutely no talking with the judges while the pageant is in session except those appointed by Bledsoe County Fair Staff to do so.
4. Anyone on the premises displaying bad sportsmanship will forfeit all winnings, their entry fee, and they will be asked to leave the premises.
5. The photogenic picture must accompany the entry fee. Do not bring your photo the day of the pageant and expect it to be judged. It should be submitted the day and time you submit your application and entry fee.
6. Please place your photo in a clear plastic bag (Ziploc, etc.) and write clearly on the back of the photo the following information: contestant name, phone number, and age group. The Bledsoe County Fair Association is not responsible for any lost or damaged photos. You can pick up your pictures the da/night of the pageant at the registration desk.
7. All Kings and Queens from each age group are asked to remain at the pageant until the intermission or until the very end to get a group photo for the paper.
8. All Kings and Queens are asked to attend the closing night of the Fair at the fairgrounds for recognition on stage. Closing night will be Saturday, August 17, 2019; all entrants are asked to be in the stands by 6:00 pm. The dress code for that night is casual, but please wear your crown and banner!
9. All Kings and Queens are asked to participate in any and all parades in Bledsoe County.
10. Dress Requirements Ages 0-8 years- Attire is Sunday Best ONLY. Ages 9-21- Formal wear ONLY.

11. The Bledsoe County Fair Board reserves the right to combine, eliminate, or otherwise rearrange the age groups of the pageant at any time.
12. The entry fee for all 0-15 year olds is \$20.00, and the entry fee for ages 16-21 is FREE.
Photographers will be available 1 hr prior to pageant beginning.

Age Group 16-21 Fair Queen

1. Fairest of the Fair Queen in age group 16-21 will represent Bledsoe County in the State pageant in Murfreesboro, TN in January. She will receive two days lodging, and a \$250.00 check for expenses following the Tennessee Association of Fairs Convention. If the Queen cannot attend the entire convention or chooses not to compete in the pageant, she will be held responsible for her own lodging, and will not receive her check for expenses. The 1st runner up will compete in her place. When the queen has completed her duties and makes her final walk as previous queen at the 2020 pageant, she will receive her scholarship check in the amount of \$250.00 if she is currently enrolled in college. (proof will be required). If queen is still in high school, the scholarship will be paid prior to college entrance with requested proof of enrollment.
2. Contestants whose 16th birthday is within one week of the pageant may opt to move up to the 16-21 year old age group.
3. Past crowned queens on the 16-21 year old age group may not compete in the pageant again.
4. Bledsoe County Fair Association reserves the right at any time, if so deemed necessary, to replace the Queen with the 1st alternate.
5. Contest is open to all contestants age eligible. If you have previously participated at the state level, you are still eligible to enter but of crowned Queen, you will not be eligible to represent Bledsoe at Sate Fairest of the Fair pageant according to TN state rules. The 1st runner up will represent Bledsoe County.
